#### General information

**The official call for project proposals in the above mentioned programme will be published on 5<sup>th</sup> October. Please find the programme's research topics enclosed. The participation at the Matchmaking is not a condition to submit a project proposal for the upcoming call.**

Please submit a CV of the person who is to take part in the matchmaking workshop and describe their role within your university until **14<sup>th</sup> September 2022 (0.00 am)**

In addition, please submit a sketch of the planned research project and the university collaboration as well as a description of its feasibility within your university (one page)

Criteria that you should focus on in your project abstract:

- Scalability of research results
- related to the potential impact on policy
- if your proposal potentially contributes to more than one of the call's target topic (say, H2 + sector interface + mobility)

**The following outcomes will be the basis of the programme:**

- Research results in both countries are applicable and increasingly used
- The performance of science-related institutes and universities is improved.
- The international and national networking of the cooperation partners and other actors (research institutes, Brazilian authorities) has been strengthened

On basis of the documents submitted, DAAD, together with GIZ, will select and invite those people who are eligible for the project.



## Eligible expenditure

If an invitation has been issued and you have travelled to the matchmaking workshop, DAAD will reimburse you upon submission of individual receipts:

- Expenses for mobility (travel and flight, 2nd class/economy flight) from the place of residence to the venue and back as well as expenses for the stay at the venue.

Note: DAAD reserves the right to commission an event agency for the selected participants to organise and carry out all or part of the trip (international flights, transport in Ecuador, accommodation, meals, etc.).

In case of unforeseen, travel restrictions due to the global COVID-19 pandemic the matchmaking workshop may be held virtually. The selected participants will be informed in due time.
