

## **Rules for the qualification program for doctoral agreements according to the Doctoral Degree Regulations 2016 and 2019**

### **Rules:**

1. Three groups are defined (as indicated below). Offers from GRADUS can be considered in these groups.
2. At least one activity must be chosen from at least 2 of the 3 groups.
3. For each activity, there is a minimum number of points that must be awarded to the doctoral candidate and a maximum number of points that may be awarded to the doctoral candidate.
4. No activity may be considered more than twice.
5. Courses that have already been attended during the studies qualifying for the doctoral degree or for which an examination has already been taken cannot be considered.
6. The supervisor is responsible for further details and specifications .

### **Scientific achievements**

- Conference participation with own contribution (poster or presentation), 1 to 3 points
- Scientific publication with DOI, ISSN or ISBN, 1 to 3 points
- Visiting scientist stay of at least one week duration and with a lecture, 1 to 3 points
- Approved grant application for third-party funds with doctoral student as applicant, alone or jointly, 1 to 3 points

### **Scientific qualification**

- Attendance of a lecture in a specialization subject or equivalent, without examination 1 to 3 points, with examination number of ECTS of the module.
- Participation in a scientific event corresponding to the topic of the doctorate, conference, workshop, summer school, etc., 1 to 3 points.

### **Miscellaneous**

- Attendance of advanced training for scientific soft skills, 1 to 3 points.
- Public relations activities in the field of scientific dissemination.
- Activity as Chairman Organizing Committee with less than 200 participants 1 to 3
- Activity as a member of the Organizing Committee with more than 200 participants 1 to 3
